Objective: To be able to order food in a restaurant.

Practice: Role Play

Have one student be the waiter and the other be the customers. Have the waiter give out the menus and role play ordering food

Sample Dialog 1:

- C. May we see the menu, please?
 W. Sure, here it is.
 W. Can I take your order?
 C. Yes, I'd like Chicken and a milkshake.
 W. How about you?
 C. I'd like a sandwich.
 W. (Would you like) anything to drink?
 C. No. there you but water
- C. No, thank you. Just water.

- 2. Bye.

Key Vocabulary
