

Cowl « Arc en Ciel » (Rainbow)

Material:

- 4 bowls of wool « gigante » from Lanagrossa(50g/30meters), here color 2313.(Or any big wool you can knit with needles 10mm or 12mm minimum).

- Needles n°15.

Cast on 33 stitches,

Knitting the 4 bowls in "côtes 1/1" :

Row 1 (right side): 1 selvedge stitche, *1 knit, 1 purl*, repeat from * to *, and finish the row with 1 knit and 1 selvedge stitche.

Row 2(wrong side) : 1 selvedge stitche, 1 purl, *1 knit, 1 purl*, selvedge stitche repeat from* to * and finish with one selvedge stitche.

Always repeat these two rows.

Watch out: keep enough wire length to cast off and sew the cowl.

For casting off:

On the right side of your work: cast off the selvedge stitche on the first knit.

Do a Yarn Over on the right needle.

Cast off this first knit on this Yarn over.

Bring down from the left needle the next purl and undo this stitch till bottom of your work.

Cast off flexibly: *the next knit, purl on the next **knit** and do a Yarn over the right needle where you cast off the **knit** Bring down from the left needle the next purl and undo this stitch till bottom of your work.*

Repeat from *to* and when you have only one knit and one selvedge stitche: cast off, fasten off, do the sewing of the cowl!
