

# Cowl Omega

(Reversible)

## Material:

4 skeins of Nebula Artesano.

Circular needles 4.5mm with a cable of 80 or 100cms.

1 stitch marker.

## Points and abbreviations:

k: knit

p: purl

\* ... \* repeat from \* to \* until the end of the round



R: round.

Gauge: 16 stitches/ 20 rows.

Size of the cowl: 24/65cm.

## Work:

Cast on flexibly (in long cast tail) 200 stitches, put the stitch marker to mark the beginning of the round and start to knit :

R 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11 and 12: \*k4, p4\*

R 5, 6, 7, 8, 13, 14, 15 and 16: \*p4, k4\*

Then repeat the following pattern of 4 rounds until your cowl do 20 cm:

R 1 and 2: \*k1, p2, k1\*

R 3 and 4: \*p1, k2, p1\*

At the desired height, work:

R 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11 and 12: \*k4, p4\*

R 5, 6, 7, 8, 13, 14, 15 and 16: \*p4, k4\*

Bind off all stitches flexibly the 200 stitches.

Bring in the threads dutifully to keep your fully reversible collar, cut threads, block.
