## Cadres take over

Although there was no official confirmation from the police, CPM district secretariat member Ashok Guria said "all the homeless CPM supporters, who were thrown out of their houses at gunpoint, have returned to their homes till the Kendemari area. Now there are no homeless people in Nandigram Block-I."

But Trinamool MLA Sishir Adhikari claimed that CPM is yet to get control of five out of 17 blocks of Nandigram and that they would again enter the places on Monday, which CPM tried to enter today with more than 50,000 people. However, a local SUCI leader Bhabani Prasad Das present at Nandigram Bazar said all is lost for BUPC in Nandigram and now fleets of homeless are coming to the relief camps for shelter.

Later in the evening, a dejected Mamata Banerjee told the media: "What will CRPF do now in Nandigram? Will they guard the broken houses and empty villages. CPM goons have destroyed everything."

When questioned on whether she would go to Nandigram and protest, Mamata said "I wanted to see the villagers, not the CPM goons". Then she went on to say, "was my silent protest not enough".
